4.7 Refunds

Entryfeeswillberefundedinfullonly:

- To competitors whose entry has not been accepted
- In the case of Autocross not taking place

The organizers may refund 50% of the entry fees to those competitors who, for reasons of “Force Majeure”, duly accepted by the Organising Committee, were unable to start in the event.

5. INSURANCE

Organizers holding a valid 2025 FMSCI Permit for an event are covered for:

Competitors: A maximum of 250 competitors with valid FMSCI Competition License participating in various events across the Country on a given day are covered for Personal Accident Insurance for Rs. 5 lakhs with Rs. 5 Lakhs medical expense extension per person.

Officials: A maximum of 100 officials officiating in various events across the Country on a given day are covered for Personal Accident Insurance for Rs.25 lakhs with Rs.5 lakhs medical expense extension per person.

Due to ever increasing cost of hospitalization, and due to inherent risk involved in our sport, It is decided to make it mandatory for all the competition licence holders who are taking part in our National Championship level events to be covered for a minimum of Rs.10 lakhs towards Medical Insurance.

Bajaj Allianz gives two options for medical insurance (not cashless). Both the options are for one year and for Rs.10 lakhs.

Option 1 with Rs.5 lakhs deductible i.e. upto 5 lakhs the competitor will have to bear the expenses (Rs.5 lakhs cover by the FMSCI could be used) and over and above Rs.5 lakhs and upto Rs.10 lakhs, this option would cover.

Option 2 is without any deductible amount, i.e. the insurance would cover medical expenses up to Rs.10 lakhs

Please note that it is entirely up to the Competitors to discuss with them and decide on the options.

6. FORMAT OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

- Each driver has to register with the FMSCI for allocation of points for the Qualifying Rounds, on or before 5 pm on the Wednesday, immediately preceding before the start of qualifying rounds.
- Only the registered driver will be allocated points for the qualifying rounds without taking in to account the position of the unregistered drivers.
- A driver can register only for 3 classes in the qualifying rounds which will be considered for the finals.
- The Championship will consist of 7 qualifying rounds which will be run as a Cup.
- To qualify for the Championship Final, each registeredDriver must take part in at least 2 qualifying rounds from any Zone in the Country.
- The registereddrivers would be allocated points for each qualifying round as per Art.8.
- If a registereddriver has taken part in more than 2 qualifying rounds, driver's best two points only would be counted.
- The first 5 positions in each class, irrespective of zones would be eligible for finals.
- **A driver cannot take part in more than 3 classes in the Grand Finals.**
- **A maximum of three different drivers may use one car in a specific class.**
- The Champion in each class will be declared in a Grand Final that will be held at the end of the 7 qualifying rounds.

The dates for the respective qualifying rounds and the Grand Final will be announced in the FMSCI Calendar of Events. Once the dates are finalized the order/venue of the rounds may change.

Dead Heat in the qualifying: According to the greater number of first places, then second places, then third places, etc. achieved in the qualifying rounds in their respective classes. In the event of a further tie, the qualifier/s will be decided by the decision of the FMSCI.

7. RUNNING OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The Qualifying Rounds and the Grand Finals will run in a Twin Track/Car format. In the case of Force Majeure, a single-track format may be run.

The design Specifications of the track should follow articles: 15,16.1, 27 and 30 of the 2025 General Prescriptions / Sporting Regulations for Autocross.

The surface may be Gravel, Tarmac or Mixed in any ratio as deemed fit.

9. FMSCI LICENCE REQUIREMENT

All Drivers taking part in the Qualifying rounds and / or Finals must be in possession of valid 2025 FMSCI National level 4W Competition Licence either for Drag / Autocross, Racing or Rally. Please note that Grassroots, One event, Club Sport licences are NOT VALID for Qualifying Rounds and Finals.

10. ADVERTISEMENT

It is COMPULSORY to carry Organisers Advertisement on the vehicle during the event. All advertisements must conform to Art.12 of the 2025 FMSCI General Prescriptions / Sporting Regulations for Autocross.

11. DOCUMENTATION

The following original documents are MANDATORILY required to be shown during pre-event documentation:

- 1) 2025 FMSCI Competition Licence for Driver
- 2) 2025 FMSCI Competition Licence for Competitor (if the Driver is a minor)
- 3) 2025 FMSCI Competition Licence for Entrant / Team (If the Entrant is a Team)
- 4) PAN Card for the Driver
- 5) Vehicle Authorisation Letter from the Owner of the vehicle if the driver is not the owner
- 6) High Risk Hospitalization Insurance Policy for a minimum of Rs.5 Lakhs (Only for Finals)
- 7) Passport Size Photograph of the Driver – 3 Nos.

14. PARC FERME

The scrutineers may convert a part of the paddock area or similar nearby suitable area into a Parc ferme to hold some competing cars for post event inspection. Some physical demarcation,

to physically define this area will be done. All Parc ferme rules will apply in this area ensuring no unauthorized entry into this space is allowed.

Vehicles parked in this area may be removed at the end of the event as per programme after the protest period has elapsed, subject to the approval of the Stewards of the Meet.

For the National Championship Round:

The Technical Delegate/scrutineers shall convert a part of the paddock area or similar nearby suitable area into a Parc ferme to hold some competing cars for post event inspection. Some physical demarcation, to physically define this area will should be done. All Parc ferme rules will apply in this area ensuring no unauthorized entry into this space is allowed.

In case of multiple driver's driving the same car, every driver will have to report to the Parc Ferme after his/her run in a particular class. The next driver for his/her run will have to take the car from the Parc Ferme and report straight to the Start line. In case of any repairs to be done at the Parc Ferme between 2 runs, the same should be carried out under the supervision of the Scrutineer/Parc Ferme Marshall. In case of a car breakdown on the track, the car needs to be towed into the Parc Ferme where repairs can be carried out under supervision as above. If the car is beyond repair and cannot take part any further in the event, a letter needs to be given to the COC/SOM of the meet indicating the same. Under no circumstances can repairs be carried out in the individual pits.

15. POST EVENT SCRUTINY & FINAL CHECKS

16.2 Appeals

Appeal Deposit: Rs.96,000/=+18%GST.TotalRs.113,280/=

Competitors may appeal against decisions, in accordance with the stipulations set out in Articles 15.1 of the Code.

Competitors, Drivers or other license-holders that are addressees of a stewards' decision or that are individually affected by such decision, whatever their nationality, shall have the right to appeal against that decision before the ASN of the country in which it was given. They must, however, under pain of forfeiture of their right to appeal, notify the Stewards of the meeting in writing within one hour of the publication of the decision, of their intention to appeal.

The right to bring an appeal to the FMSCI along with the Appeal deposit expires 96 hours from the moment the stewards are notified of the intention to appeal on condition that the intention of appealing has been notified in writing to the stewards within one hour of the publication of the decision.

This appeal may be brought by fax or by any other electronic means of communication with confirmation of receipt. Confirmation by a letter of the same date accompanied by the necessary fee is required. The FMSCI will give its decision within a maximum of 30 days.

All parties concerned shall be given adequate notice of the hearing of any appeal. They shall be entitled to call witnesses, but their failure to attend the hearing shall not interrupt the course of the proceedings.

The confirmation of an appeal to the FMSCI must be accompanied by a deposit of Rs.96,000/- +18% GST.Total Rs.113,280/=.

This fee becomes due from the moment the appellant notifies the Stewards of the intention of appealing and remains payable even if the appellant does not follow up on the declared intention to appeal.

If the appeal is rejected or it is withdrawn after being brought, no part of the fee shall be returned.

If judged partially founded, the fee may be returned in part, and its entirety if the appeal is upheld.

If it is proved that the author of the appeal has acted in bad faith, the FMSCI may inflict upon them one of the penalties laid down in the Code.

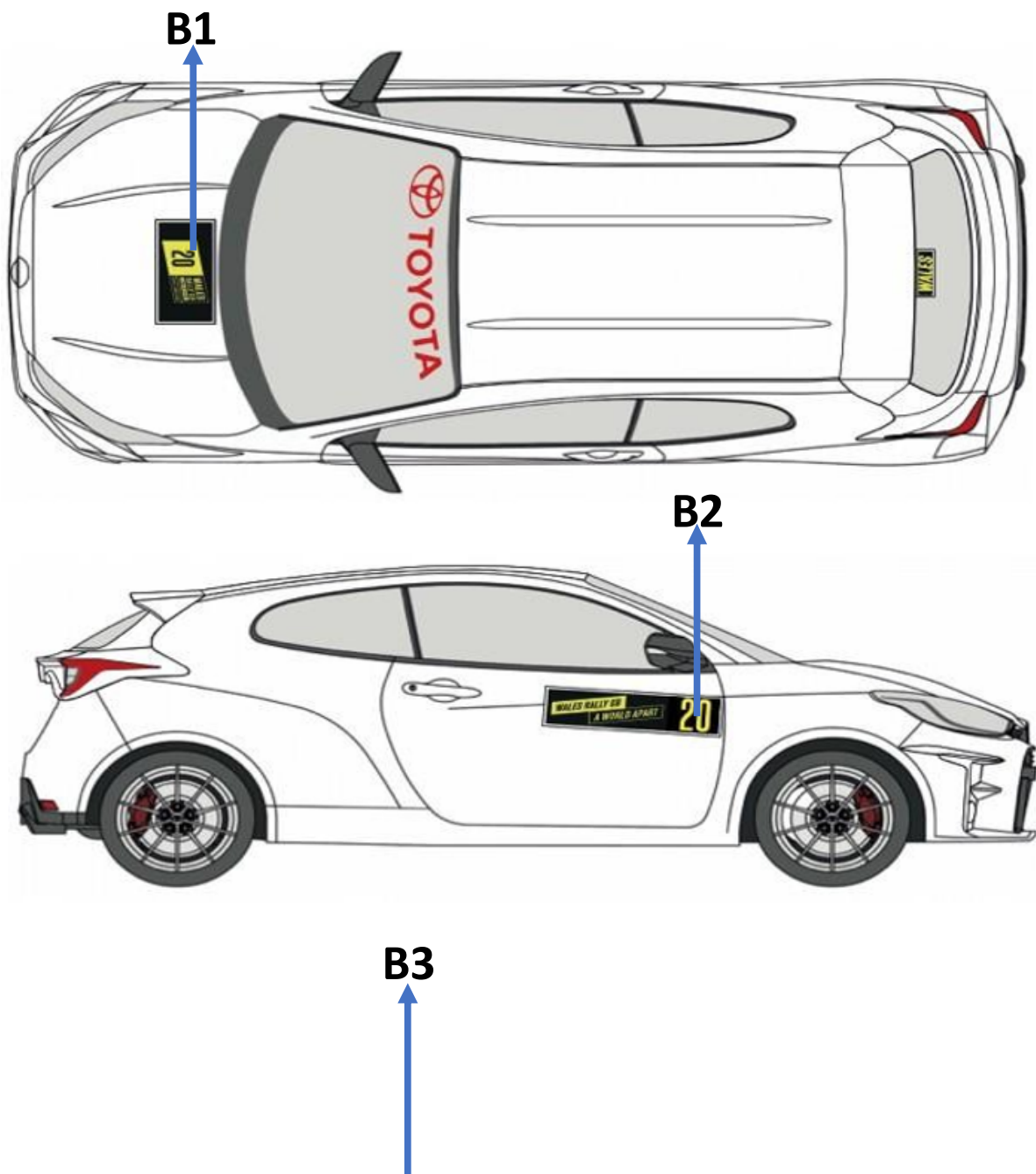
