In the case of offline entry, those wishing to take part in this Rally must submit their entry form on or before the time and date mentioned in Art.4.1 above to the organisers address as mentioned in Art.2.3 above.

4.3 Number of Competitors Accepted

The maximum number of entries accepted is **75**. If, by the close of entries, the organizers receive more entries than the maximum number specified here in the Supplementary Regulations, then priority is given to the entries of Championship Registered Drivers.

- FMSCI Classic Challenge Regulations.
- Cars competing in FMSCI Classic Challenge will not be classified in the INRC Classifications.

- Minimum eligible age of drivers is 45 years + (As on 1st April of the year of the Cup).
- No Minimum age for Co-drivers.

- Those who have been FMSCI seeded in the past 5 years are not eligible.

4.7 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- To candidates whose entry has not been accepted.
- In the case of the rally not taking place.
- In the case of force majeure for the competitor, after investigation by the Stewards.

The organizers may refund 50% of the entry fees to those competitors who, for reasons of “Force Majeure”, duly accepted by the Organising Committee, were unable to start in the Rally.

5. INSURANCE

5.1 Insurance cover with FMSCI Permit

Competitors: A maximum of 300 competitors with valid FMSCI Competition Licenses participating in various events across the Country on a given day are covered for Personal Accident Insurance for Rs.10 lakhs with Rs.5 Lakhs medical expense extension per person.

Officials: A maximum of 150 officials officiating in various events across the Country on a given day are covered for Personal Accident Insurance for Rs.25 lakhs with Rs.5 lakhs medical expense extension per person.

In addition to the above all competitors must possess valid high-risk hospitalization benefits preferably a cashless policy for a minimum of Rs.5 lakhs.

5.2 Third-Party Public Liability Insurance taken by the Organising Club /FMSCI

The Organising Club /FMSCI have taken a third party public liability for Rs.5 crores incurred during the running of the rally for injury to third persons or damage to public property.

5.3 Exclusion of Insurance Cover

The Service and Reconnaissance vehicles, even those bearing Special Plates supplied by the organizers are never considered as official participants of the Rally. They are therefore not covered by the Insurance Policy of the Rally and will remain the sole responsibility of their owners.

5.4 Accident Reporting

If a driver taking part in a rally is involved in an accident in which a member of the public sustains physical injury, the driver concerned must report this to the next radio point as specified in the road book and signposted on the route according to Article 53 of GP. If he fails to observe this rule, the Stewards may impose on the crew responsible, a penalty which may go as far as disqualification. The laws of the country must also be complied with in relation to procedures at accidents.

5.5 Rally Cover Insurance for Competing Vehicles

The competing vehicles must possess **Rally Cover Insurance valid from 19th September and 20th September 2026. (2 days)**

6. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1 Competition Numbers, advertising and Driver's and Co-Driver's names

These will be in accordance with Articles 27, 28 & 29 of the **2026** FMSCI General Prescriptions for Stage Rallies and Art.8 of Specific Regulations for INRC.

6.2 Organizers optional advertising

These will be in accordance with Art.8.2 of the **2026** Specific Regulations for INRC.

6.3 Space for Organizers optional advertising

Space for the Organizer's advertisement must be reserved on the car, unless the higher entry fees as per Art. 4.5 are paid.

6.4 Advertising in Service Park Bay Area

Display of advertisements by teams & participants, in their respective Service Park Bay Area, must be confined to the inner walls of the Bay. Any advertising space other than the inner walls will need the prior permission of the organizer's and cost Rs.1000/- Per Sq. ft. Organizers shall have the discretion to refuse or cancel permission at any point in time.

6.5 Hospitality Area

Teams and Manufacturers can put in multiples of 20 x 20 feet Hospitality Areas. Size based on availability as confirmed by the organiser. The cost of the space is capped to max Rs.100 Per Sq Ft. the cost for this rally is Rs.TBA Per Sq. ft. Organizers shall have the discretion based on first come first serve and available area.

6.6 Championship Identification and Advertisement.

Should comply to GP 29.5 as per Appendix IV of the SR.

7. TYRES

7.1 Tyres Specified for use during the rally

Tyres shall conform to Appendix IV of **2026** FMSCI General Prescriptions.

8. FUEL

Free as per **2026** Technical Regulations for Rallying.

9. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 Procedure for Registration

Crews must report to Rally Headquarters for registration prior to commencing reconnaissance. They must submit details of the reconnaissance car.

Each crew will be issued with two vehicle identification cards which must be displayed on the top of the co-driver's side of the front windscreen and on the co-driver's rear side window during reconnaissance, and a pass valid for up to TWO passages over each special stage. This pass must be carried in the reconnaissance vehicle, shown to and endorsed by an official at the start and finish of each special stage during reconnaissance.

9.2 Specific and /or National Restrictions

- 9.2.1 For all competitors, reconnaissance will be carried out in accordance with the FMSCI General Prescriptions with a maximum of 2 passes over every stage in accordance with the reconnaissance schedule given in Appendix II.
- 9.2.2 Reconnaissance outside the schedule will be considered a very serious offence and will be reported to the Stewards who may apply sanctions.
- 9.2.3 Reconnaissance will be conducted strictly in accordance with the published schedule. No late entry into a stage for reconnaissance will be permitted.
- 9.2.4 Maximum speed allowed on all special stages during reconnaissance is 45 Km/h except Super Special Stage.
- 9.2.5 Crews must have the vehicle headlamps switched on while traveling on special stages during reconnaissance.
- 9.2.6 Crews are only permitted to enter a special stage from the start points shown in the road book and will NOT under any circumstances drive in a direction opposite to that of the rally, unless instructed by an official of the event.
- 9.2.7 Crews must stop at the Start and Finish (and other locations where instructed) of the stage where rally official will endorse the crew's reconnaissance pass card.
- 9.2.8 Penalties for excessive speed
Refer Art. 34.2 of the **2026** FMSCI General Prescriptions.

All rally vehicles during an event will be tracked by TEQTO (Track Race) for safety of the competitors. While the competitors need to purchase Fitting Kit (one time purchase per season) @Rs.2,500/= (including GST of 18%) from TEQTO. Contact Mr.Vinod Kumar N @ 7259465110.

Apart from the above, a security deposit of Rs.5000/= (Rupees Five Thousand Only) either by way of bank transfer or cash to be paid to TEQTO for the data logger. If paid by cash, the deposit would be returned immediately at the time of handing over the data logger without any damage. If paid by bank transfer, TEQTO would transfer it back to the competitor within 2 working days of handing over the data logger without any damage.

During pre-event scrutiny, the installation and working of the TEQTO systems will be checked.

12.1 Ceremonial Start

Venue : **Rally HQ 2**

Pre event holding area will remain open from 16.30hrs to 17.00hrs for the cars invited to the ceremonial start.

Any car reporting outside this time will be penalized @ Rs.100/ Per Minute.

Pre-event press conference / interaction will commence at 16.00hrs.

Spectators will be allowed to take photographs of the cars.

Competitors who do not take part in the Ceremonial Start will be referred to Stewards for further sanctions,

The start Interval will be as directed by the officials.

12.2 Finish Procedure

Rally will finish at **TC 9B**. There after crews must follow the instructions of officials during the podium finish ceremony. From podium, selected cars are obliged to follow the route as directed to the Final Scrutineering. Rest of the cars will report to Finish Parc Ferme and remain there till official final classification or instruction by Stewards of the meet.

While the cars are between Podium Finish to Final Scrutineering location, they will travel under Parc Ferme regulations and will be observed by marshals.

12.3 Permitted early check-in

Crews may check in early without incurring any penalty at

TC – 6C & TC - 9B

12.4 Start Procedures

12.4.1 Super Special Stage (if applicable)

As per the Start Order published.

12.4.2 Special Stage

A photocell placed 40 - 75 cm from the starting line will be used to detect the jump starts. Should the system fail, the start will be given as per Art. 48.2 of the **2026 FMSCI** General Prescriptions for Stage Rallies.

12.4.3 Start Reporting Procedures

Competitors should report to the start **TC 0**, 10 minutes before their start time. Late reporting will be penalized by Rs.1,000/- per minute.

12.5 Special Procedures

Time cards will be issued/changed during the rally and will be issued at the following controls.
TC- 0, TC – 3D and TC – 6D

12.6 Official Time Used during the Rally

Official time to be used during the rally will be that of GPS time (GMT +5.30 Hrs). This will be given at the time of Driver's Briefing.

12.7 Start Area

Before the start of the competitive element of the rally, the organisers may assemble all the competing cars in a starting area, into which cars must be driven before the start time as detailed in the supplementary regulations. The exclusively pecuniary penalties for late arrival in the starting area shall be Rs.1000/= per minute. No service is allowed in the start area.

Any crew reporting more than 15 minutes late at the start of a section shall not be allowed to start that section.

16. PROTESTS & APPEALS

16.1 PROTESTS

The protest fee is Rs.18,000/= + 18% GST. Total Rs.21,240/= for National Championship

The Protest fee is Rs.12,000/= + 18% GST. Total Rs.14,160/= for Cups, Challenge and Series

In the case of a protest referring to the alleged non-compliance of an *Automobile* with the regulations and requiring the dismantling and re-assembly of clearly defined part or parts of an *Automobile*, an additional deposit to cover the estimated costs involved in such checks may be specified by the stewards on a proposal from the FIA technical delegate (if appointed) or the chief scrutineer. This additional deposit must be paid by the protester within one hour

upon receipt of such notification of the stewards (or, where appropriate, within such timeframe as agreed by them). Otherwise, the protest will be deemed inadmissible.

The costs incurred in undertaking such checks shall be borne:

- by the protester if the protest is rejected. If the costs incurred are less than the additional deposit paid, the surplus shall be refunded to the protester. Conversely, if the costs incurred are higher, the difference shall be borne by the protester, in accordance with the principles set out in Articles 12.8.1 and 12.8.2 of the International Sporting Code.
- by the *Competitor* against whom the protest is filed if the protest is upheld. Under such circumstances: (i) the costs incurred shall be paid by the *Competitor* in accordance with the principles set out in Articles 12.8.1 and 12.8.2 of the International Sporting Code and (ii) the additional deposit paid by the protester shall be refunded.
- Proportionally by the parties if the protest is partially upheld. Such proportionality shall be determined by the stewards. The proportion allocated to the protesting party will be deducted from the additional deposit paid and the balance will be refunded. The proportion allocated to the *Competitor* against whom the protest is lodged shall be paid in accordance with the principles set out in Articles 12.8.1 and 12.8.2. of the International Sporting Code

16.2 APPEALS

Appeal Deposit: Rs.96,000/= + 18% GST. Total Rs.113,280/=

Competitors may appeal against decisions, in accordance with the stipulations set out in Articles 15.1 of the Code.

Competitors, Organisers, Drivers or other licence-holders that are addressees of a stewards' decision or that have a legal interest to act (personal, direct, existing, and current), whatever their nationality, shall have the right to appeal against that decision before the *ASN* of the country in which it was given.

They must notify the stewards in writing of their intention to appeal within one hour of the publication of the decision.

In circumstances where the stewards consider that compliance with the one-hour deadline would be impossible, the latter may set a different time limit for the notification of the intention to appeal. This time limit shall then be set down in writing in their decision and shall not exceed 24 hours following the publication of the decision. The

time limit for bringing an appeal to an ASN and the payment of the appeal deposit shall be deferred accordingly.

Failure to notify the stewards in writing of the intention to appeal within the time limit set, as applicable, shall result in the inadmissibility of the appeal.

The right to bring an appeal to an ASN expires 96 hours from the moment the stewards are notified of the intention to appeal on condition that the intention to appeal has been notified in writing to the stewards within one hour of the publication of the decision.

This appeal may be brought by any electronic means of communication with confirmation of receipt. Confirmation by a letter of the same date is required.

The ASN must give its decision within a maximum of 30 days.

All parties concerned shall be given adequate notice of the hearing of any appeal. They shall be entitled to call witnesses, but their failure to attend the hearing shall not interrupt the course of the proceedings.

The confirmation of an appeal to the FMSCI must be accompanied by a deposit of Rs. 96,000/- +18% GST. Total Rs. 113,280/=.

This fee becomes due from the moment the appellant notifies the Stewards of the intention of appealing and remains payable even if the appellant does not follow up on the declared intention to appeal.

If the appeal is rejected or it is withdrawn after being brought, no part of the fee shall be returned.

If judged partially founded, the fee may be returned in part, and its entirety if the appeal is upheld.

If it is proved that the author of the appeal has acted in bad faith, the FMSCI may inflict upon them one of the penalties laid down in the Code.

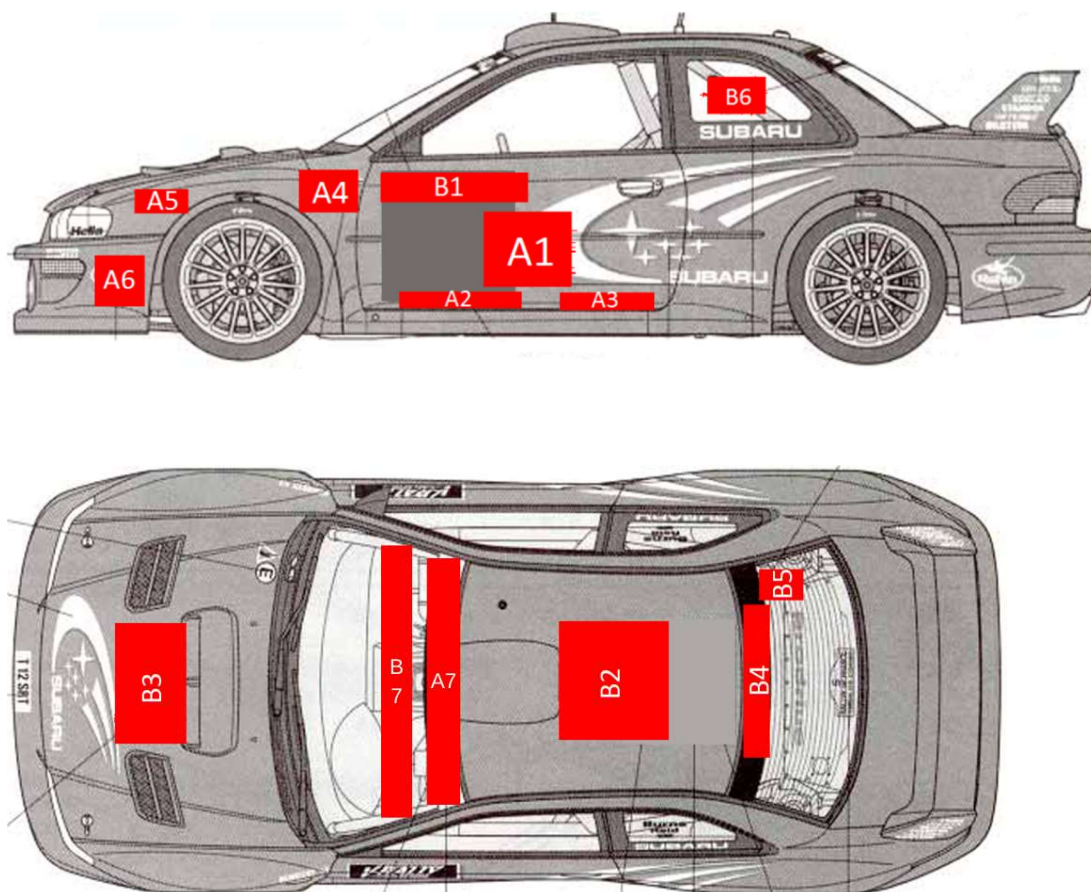

Annexure 1 : Safety Tracking System

Track Race Safety Tracking

About the System

Track Race is a vehicle communication system that automatically transmits warnings and vehicle status data from car to Race Control as quickly as possible

The use of Track Race for these events is based on their use of a reliable GSM network and GPS satellite network, the system's ability to relay status and location through efficiently.

Installation of the System

There is a detailed installation guide attached, here are some KEY items you should be aware of.

Installation Kit: The car installation kit has to be purchased one time by the competitor for the INRC season by contacting the Track Race team. You will receive a kit that consists of the wiring loom, Console kit with buttons for SOS, OK and yellow flag. This needs to be installed in the car well in advance. The units provide screw mounting holes to mount if you want to prepare your car ahead of time and use a better mounting location.

FULL TIME Power: The units need to run full time power, not switched power. The power lead for the unit is about two meter long.

Unit Placement: The ideal location for the unit is in the centre of the car. **It is crucial that the unit is visible to the co-driver while on stage.**

Understanding the unit

It is important to understand that Track Race does NOT replace the normal rally procedure. You must still display an OK sign if you're OK and you must still SEE an OK sign before continuing past a car stopped on stage. When you approach a car stopped on stage or your car is stopped on stage, here are the options you will see.

S.O.S. (Red – Toggle Switch): This means the crew is **NOT OK and needs help. YOU MUST STOP.** The SOS is automatically selected in a high energy impact. **If you are the first car to stop at a SOS and confirm it is a RED CROSS situation, manually upgrade to SOS status on your unit as well.** Continue following normal procedures and send information on to the next radio point. If you are stopped in stage and require immediate assistance activate the SOS button.

Hazard (Yellow – LED with Buzzer): This means there is a Hazard on the stage ahead. **This COULD mean the stage is completely blocked** and you may have to stop. This is the default status when a car stops on stage.

OK (Green – Momentary push switch): This means you are ok and the stage is clear for following cars to continue. Press and hold upto two seconds to confirm. The ok button can be used to acknowledge when a Hazard flag is received on the console.

Collecting/Returning the Tracker Units

The tracker units should be collected from Track Race team by paying a security deposit during documentation or before scrutiny. We will collect back the tracker units at the end of the event.

Please be prepared to disconnect the power wires to the unit. The security deposit will be refunded when the unit is returned sealed and in working order.

Track Race Car Installation Kit Components

The Track Race Car Installation Kit includes:

- Track Race Installation and Car Installation Kit Instruction Sheet;
- 12V wiring loom with plug and inline fuse
- Console kit having SOS, Hazard and OK switches and alert buzzers.

(The Track Race Tracker Unit is not a part of the Car Installation Kit and will be available at documentation or scrutiny)

12 Volt Power Supply (Please read this carefully)

Track Race requires a continual reliable power supply from 9 to 24 volts DC, for your safety and continuity of service, it is imperative that the unit is connected to an un-switched supply on the battery positive terminal or the battery positive side of the isolation switch, insure that power is supplied to the unit at all times. Do not use an ignition switched power supply. We recommend that

a 5 amp (Max) blade type or similar quality fuse is used at the battery supply end of the Track Race power lead. 0 volts or Battery negative can be picked up at any suitable earthing point providing the isolation switch does not switch the negative side of the battery.

The Track Race unit has an internal battery that is kept charged via the cars power supply, it is only there as a reserve supply to power the unit in an accident situation where the cars power supply is interrupted. ie: car battery smashed or dislodged.

As the Track Race unit is aware of movement and its location; it will automatically go into power save/sleep mode 15 minutes after no movement is detected, however, the unit will continue to function is when it is sending Hazard type signals while on stage. The unit will be "woken" up by pressing any button or by movement of the car.

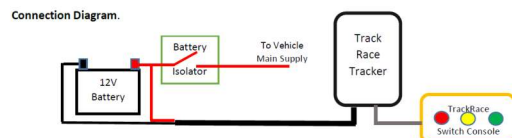


Photo of Connections and Terminals



A minimum of 100mm of TrackRace Power Supply Cable and Console cable should be left at the unit mounting location for connection to the unit.

Unit Mounting

The preferred mounting method for the Track Race Console unit is bolted through the dash (with a 3mm aluminum backing plate), in a protected central location, easily seen and accessible by both the driver and co-driver/nav. Photographs of the best mounting options and positioning are below.

An alternative mounting method for the Track Race Console unit is on the roll cage.

The Track Race Tracking unit should be mounted in center of the dashboard towards the windshield with wires preferably coming from the left side of the dashboard.

These photos are an example of Preferred Method, Dash Board positioning.
